Serving its objective of helping children experience the exhilaration and joy of learning, SOAR provides a wealth of diverse and challenging activities for SCS children of all ages. The thrill of learning is enhanced through shared activities and mutual discovery. Building on that strength, SOAR invites members of our community to join us in a true celebration of knowledge by participating in our first SOAR Bowl! Teams of 4, consisting of students in **grades 3 up through adults** are invited to take part in a game that encourages children and adults to share their unique reserves of knowledge in a fun-filled competition. Teams with multi-generations are encouraged and will have a distinct advantage!

We will have 10 categories of questions (along with some possible miscellaneous ones):

Math; History; Science; Pop Culture; Sports; Art;
Technology; Literature; Current Events; and Geography

Within each category we will have GENERAL, LOCAL and STUDENT questions.

We invite ALL students to submit possible questions to be used for our first SOAR Bowl. On a separate piece of paper, write your questions, the categories AND the answers. There is no limit to the number of questions that you may submit, but **please try and make them questions that a 3rd through 8th grader might be able to answer.**

Here are some examples:

In the Samantha books published by The Pleasant Co., who is Samantha Parkington's best friend? (Nellie) Literature

Against what team did the SCS boys' basketball team claim a victory in the championship game this past winter? (Cornwall) Sports

Draw a set up, and solve, a lattice multiplication problem for 12x16 (192, plus drawing) Math
